Lates and Absences

Website

The website will be updated fortnightly with snapshots of our learning so make sure you check in to see what we've been doing!

Reading

Reading books will be sent home with your child and we endeavour to change them when they complete the book. The adults in class will check in with your child's reading through the term to check with their progress. Your child will be read with a teacher/ teaching assistant weekly. Please can you hear your child read daily and ensure you record it in their reading record.

Uniform

Please make sure correct uniform is worn at all times and ensure it is named. The uniform policy is on the school website. Unless it is Tuesday, the children are expected to come into school wearing their PE with their coloured house Tshirt.

Homework

Please make sure that the children have to opportunity to practice their weekly spelling words, as well as practice reading. Children are also encouraged to practice their times tables using TT Rockstars.

Numbots

Numbots log in details will be in reading records at the back. All details are the same as last term. Numbots is a website that will help your children to develop secure place value of numbers.

Spellings

Your child will bring home a spelling list that will have all the spellings ready for the first half term. These will include common exception words and words featuring our spelling rules. Each week a 'Look, Cover, Write, Check' sheet will be sent home to help with practising and spellings will be tested every Friday.

Forest School and Wellies

Our forest school slot is first thing on a Wednesday morning. Please ensure that children have a pair of wellies in school. On forest school days, please also ensure that they have a warm coat, hat and gloves.

Water Bottle

Please ensure your child comes to school with a named water bottle.
